Deanery: Doncaster

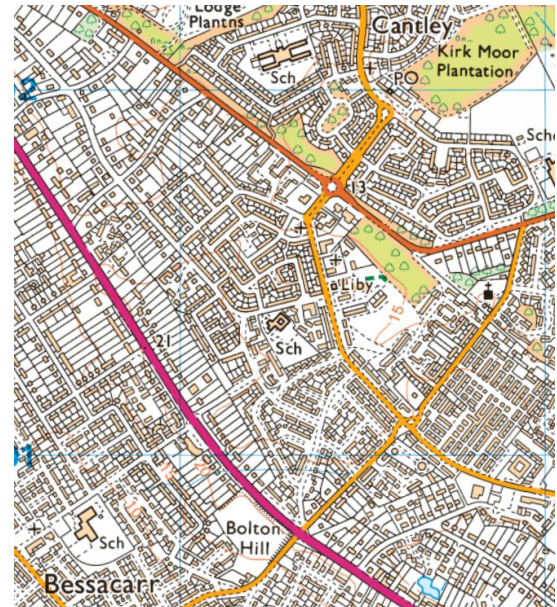
Date: Sat 18 May 2:00pm

- 4.25pm Finish

There might be refreshments at some point on the route (still being finalised): bring some water, just in case! All three churches have toilet facilities. There is a car park at St Francis Church.
