LED Lighting

LED lights are more environmentally friendly than traditional lighting technology. They use less energy and are more carbon efficient. It is a simple step to swap traditional bulbs for LED ones and is a cheap and effective way to reduce a church's carbon footprint.

Motion Sensor Switches

One of the main problems for lighting is that they can be left on when inappropriate, if no one is around then lighting is not necessary. Motion sensor and infrared switches detect the presence of someone and turn the lights on and off accordingly. This can reduce carbon output from lights by having them on only when needed. Although more expensive than replacing LEDs, it is still relatively cheap compared to other zero carbon methods and will provide a visible improvement quickly in the carbon efficiency of your church.
