CREED

Let us declare our faith in God;

We believe in God the Son, who lives in our hearts through faith, and fills us with his love.

We believe in God the Holy Spirit, who strengthens us with power from on high.

We believe in one God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Amen.

The following or other response may be used,

Lord in your mercy,

All: Hear our prayer.

At the close of the prayers:

Merciful Father,

All: Accept these prayers for the sake of your Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ, Amen.

THE PEACE

May the peace of Christ rule in our hearts, to which we are called in one body.

The peace of the Lord be always with you; **All: And also with you.**

HOLY COMMUNION

The Lord is here.

All: His Spirit is with us.

Lift up your hearts.

All: We lift them to the Lord.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All: It is right to give thanks and praise.

It is right to give you thanks in sickness and in health, in suffering and in joy, through Christ our Redeemer and Saviour, who as the Good Samaritan tends the wounds of body and spirit.

He stands by us and pours out for healing the oil of consolation and the wine of renewed hope, turning the darkness of our pain into the dawning light of his kingdom.

And now we join with saints and angels for ever praising you and *singing*:

All: Holy, holy, holy is the Lord; holy is the Lord God Almighty (x2); who was and is and is to come; Holy, holy, holy is the Lord.

The minister recalls the Last Supper...

Great is the mystery of faith:

All: Christ has died: Christ is risen: Christ will come again.

The prayer continues ... and all respond boldly:

All: Amen.

THE LORD'S PRAYER

Let us pray with confidence as our Saviour taught us:

All: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done; on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation; But deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, the power and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.
