Never do anything evil. Be kind and loving to each other, and forgive each other just as God forgave you in Christ. You are God's children whom he loves, so try to be like him.

or at the end of a gospel reading this response may be used

**TALK** 

We listen and think about what God is saying to us

After the talk a minister leads us in praying the collect a prayer which links to the theme of the service.

at the end of the prayer we reply.

All Amen.

CREE

We declare a summary of what Christians believe

Let us declare our faith in God.

We believe in God the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named.

We believe in God the Son, who lives in our hearts through faith, and fills us with his love.

We believe in God the Holy Spirit, who strengthens us with power from on high.

We believe in one God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Amen.
