Questions to consider:

- Are the PCC members clear on how Mission and Ministry is financed in the Diocese of Sheffield?
- Are the parish costs clearly understood by all PCC members? This includes local and central costs.

Other considerations:

- Current Financial situation of the parish
- Do you have a church budget?
- Do you have regular givers?
- What additional income does your church have?
- Did you receive any National Grant income?
- How has that income and congregational support been affected in the past year?

Current financial commitments:

- What are your running costs?
- Do you have a CP worker or other partially funded staff member?
- Do you have any large upcoming or recent building repair expenses?
- What is/was your pledge for 2022?

Pledge considerations:

- Are we currently Net Givers or moving towards that possibility?
- Are there indications that you should be increasing your common fund pledge
- Are there indications that you should decrease your pledge?
- Are we able to give above our costs to enable mission and ministry in other areas in the Sheffield Diocese?
- What are we able to pledge this year?
