## What is Statistics For Mission?


- An annual survey of attendance and participation.
- It covers the whole Church of England.
- Statistics for Mission has been collected since 2011.
  Previously church statistics.
- Data is collected through the Online Parish Returns System.
- Dashboard reports are available to parishes.








## A Church Near You Service Register

- Automatically prepopulate your Statistics for Mission return




### **Charts and Dashboards**

#### Statistics for Mission Dashboard - Parish:



This dashboard contains figures as submitted by churches currently in the parish. Attendance statistics have been taken from annual Statistics for Mission returns. Variations in attendance from year to year may be the result of changes in the number of churches that submitted returns, or changes in parish/benefice structure.



- · Easter: Easter Eve & Easter Day;
- Average week, October: includes Sunday and midweek church services & fresh expressions in October but excludes attendance at services for schools;

#### Statistics for Mission

Each year the national church asks churches to return a range of information about the number of people coming to church and to special services through the year. We will support you through this process.

This information is used to inform national church statistics. It is also converted into dashboards which provide local snapshots of the church community.


The National Church requests that all data is submitted by the end of January of the following year.

#### How we collect the statistics

In the Diocese of Sheffield, we use the Church of England online Parish Return system to submit both Statistics for Mission and Financial Summary Returns. We encourage parishes to enter the information directly onto the system as this reduces the administration load and also gives you more control over the data although helpful forms can be downloaded to make this process easier.




## Why is the data useful?


- Data from all churches are aggregated to produce a annual National Report.







# October Attendance Averages






# October Attendance Fresh Expressions and % Children


## **2023 October Count**
