“ Shine as a light in the world to the glory of God the Father ”

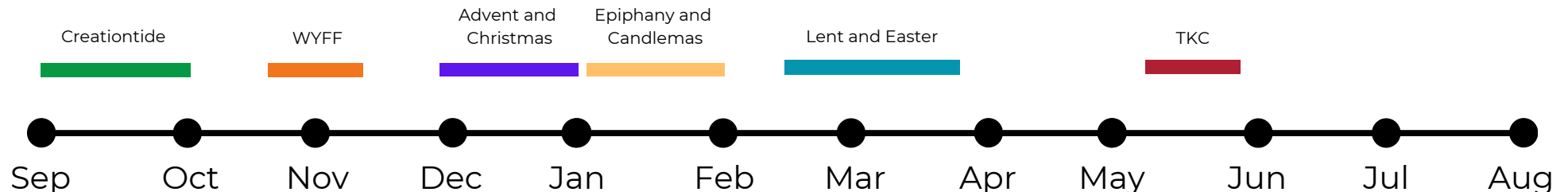
Lights for Christ is an initiative to help us live out our baptismal calling to be lights in the world – to live for Jesus in our everyday lives. We do this by:

- **Receiving** Christ's light as his friends (so that our relationship with Jesus becomes deeper)
- **Walking** in Christ's light as his followers (living so that we become more like Jesus)
- **Reflecting** Christ's light to those around us (so that others see more of Christ in us)

The central team supports leaders and the people in their churches to be Lights for Christ by creating resources, sharing ideas for developing a culture of whole-life discipleship, and promoting the use of Personal Rule of Life materials. To find out more, visit www.sheffdio.org/lfc.

Planning Ahead

Leaders may decide to use Lights for Christ as a focus during some parts of the year and not others - the central team encourages leaders to do what will work best in their context. As well as the ideas outlined above, leaders may want to run an enquirers' course at some point in the year and/or run preparation classes for baptism and confirmation. It is also important for churches to model rhythms of rest and activity throughout the year - having a fallow period can be helpful.
