

Safeguarding Learning Pathways

All of the checked courses are mandatory for the respective role. For roles that are licensed or authorised by the Bishop, having in-date training is a condition of the license. Training courses are valid for three years. Every level of course must be kept in-date. Basic and Foundations are the pre-requisites for all other courses.

3 Those with PTO who exercise a limited ministry, acting as Clerk in Holy Order only five times a year or thereabouts, are eligible for the half day PTO course as an alternative to the full leadership course.

4 Mandatory for any PCC members who work with children, young people or vulnerable adults in the broadest sense or have another role which requires this training.
