## **Safeguarding Learning Pathways**

All of the checked courses are mandatory for the respective role. For roles that are licensed or authorised by the Bishop, having in-date training is a condition of the license. Training courses are valid for three years. Every level of course must be kept in-date. Basic and Foundations are the prerequisites for all other courses.
